Day 2: Sightseeing in Riga.

Tour outline: Old Town, Riga Castle, the Dome Cathedral, St. Peter's Church, the Swedish Gate, the Three Brothers, the Large and

Small Guilds, the Freedom Monument, the Riga History and Navigation Museum. **Optional tours:** Riga Art Nouveau district and a visit to the Art Nouveau Museum. **Optional dinner:** contemporary Latvian cuisine dinner at Restaurant Kalku Varti.

Day 3: Exploring Riga's arts and crafts.

Destination: Riga.

Hotel: Radisson Blu Latvija 4* or similar.

Breakfast: at the hotel.

Tour outline: Kalnciema Quarter, Agenskalns market, local craftsman stores in the Old Town and learning about amber and knitted

fabric traditions.

Optional tours: Museum of Decorative Arts and Design (MDAD), a ballet or opera performance at the Latvian National Opera.

Day 4: Departure.
Destination: home.
Breakfast: at the hotel.

Optional transfers: from hotel to Riga Airport.
